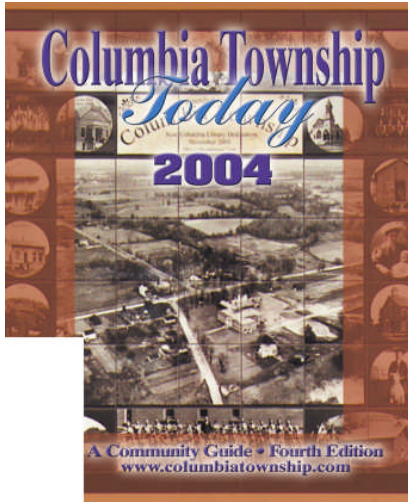
TIME TO RENEWAL YOUR CHAMBER MEMBERSHIP
